DAY 10

Barcelona, Zaragoza, Madrid (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, departure southwest through an industrial and agricultural area of significant importance in Europe. Arrival in **Zaragoza**, capital of Aragón, located on the banks of the Ebro River, the largest river in the Iberian Peninsula. Known as Caesar Augusta during the Roman period, Zaragoza played a very important role in Spanish history. Free time to visit the impressive Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar. Continue to Madrid. Overnight at the hotel.

(*) For operational reasons, the Barcelona–Madrid journey may be made by coach with the group or by high-speed train without an accompanying guide.

DAY 11

Madrid, Córdoba, Seville (B)

Arrival in **Granada** and its astonishing monumental surroundings, the last stronghold of the Nasrid Kingdom until 1492. Visit the world-famous **Alhambra complex** and the Generalife

Gardens—fountains, gardens, and courtyards whose views and sounds inspired authors such as Washington Irving in his Tales of the Alhambra. Overnight at the hotel. Optional Zambra Flamenco show in the evening.

Granada, Valencia (B)

Visit **Montjuïc Park** with spectacular views over the city and the port, the Olympic Ring, and the Columbus Monument. The afternoon is at your leisure to continue discovering the city's attractions and its varied, exquisite gastronomy. Overnight at the hotel.
