Explore the famous islands of the Venice lagoon! You'll watch glass-blowers at work on Murano, shop for lace on Burano and visit Venice's first church on the tranquil island of Torcello.

After sailing past the island of San Giorgio Maggiore, the Public Gardens, the tip of Sant'Elena and the lido famous beach resort, the boat arrives at Murano, known throughout the world for its glass manufacturing industry. Here you have 1 hour and 15 minutes for a visit to one of the factories, and discover the magic of the glass. The second stop will be at the picturesque island of Burano, famous not only for its lace, but also for the fisherman's houses painted in bright colors. The stop will last about 1 hour and 30 minutes. After a short sail, you will reach Torcello, the earliest centre of civilization in the lagoon. Only the Cathedral with its magnificent mosaics and the church of Santa Fosca remains as the testimony of its former glory. This stop lasts about 1 hour. Then the boat will make its way back to St. Mark's Square.

Explore the famous islands of the Venice lagoon! You'll watch glass-blowers at work on Murano, shop for lace on Burano and visit Venice's first church on the tranquil island of Torcello. The stop in each island is approx. of 1 hour.

After 30 minutes of navigation, you will arrive at Murano where you can experience a live Glass blowing demonstration inside one of our traditional factory.

The second stop will be at the picturesque island of Burano, famous not only for its lace, but also for the fisherman's houses painted in bright colors. This tiny but unique Venetian Island town is enriched by typical shops, restaurants and excellent bakeries where you can buy the famous "Buranelli" biscuits.

Peculiarity of the tour is the inclusion of a typical fish lunch to be tasted in Burano in a selected restaurant. The menù will include: Pennette pasta with mixed fish, mixed fried fish, mixed salad, dessert of the day (coffee and drinks not included, to be paid on spot). The child menù will include: Pasta with tomato sauce or pasta with ragout sauce, fried cutlet milanese type with french freis and dessert of the day.

Departing from Venice, this full-day journey leads you into the heart of the majestic Dolomites, a UNESCO World Heritage landscape renowned for its dramatic peaks, alpine lakes and picturesque villages.

The experience begins a comfortable drive north through the Veneto countryside. After approximately 90 minutes, the first stop is the historic town of Pieve di Cadore, birthplace of the Renaissance painter Titian. Here, guests can enjoy a short stroll and admire a breathtaking panoramic viewpoint overlooking Lake Centro Cadore, surrounded by towering mountain scenery. The journey continues toward Auronzo di Cadore, where a brief stop at the lake dam offers a striking photo opportunity, especially when the water flows powerfully through the gates. The alpine atmosphere becomes increasingly dramatic as the tour proceeds deeper into the Dolomites. A highlight of the day is the extended stop at Lake Misurina, often referred to as the “Pearl of the Dolomites.” Surrounded by iconic peaks, this crystal-clear lake provides the perfect setting for a relaxing walk along its shores. Guests will have free time for lunch at one of the local lakeside restaurants, sampling traditional mountain cuisine. During the summer months, it is also possible to rent a small rowboat or take the panoramic chairlift to Col de Varda (optional and not included) for sweeping views over the alpine landscape. In the afternoon, the tour reaches the elegant resort town of Cortina d’Ampezzo, internationally known as the “Queen of the Dolomites” and host of the 2026 Winter Olympic Games. Guests can enjoy a leisurely walk along Corso Italia, the prestigious pedestrian street lined with boutiques, cafés and alpine-style architecture, soaking in the refined mountain ambiance. At the end of the visit, the return journey to Venice concludes this unforgettable day immersed in the natural beauty of northern Italy.
