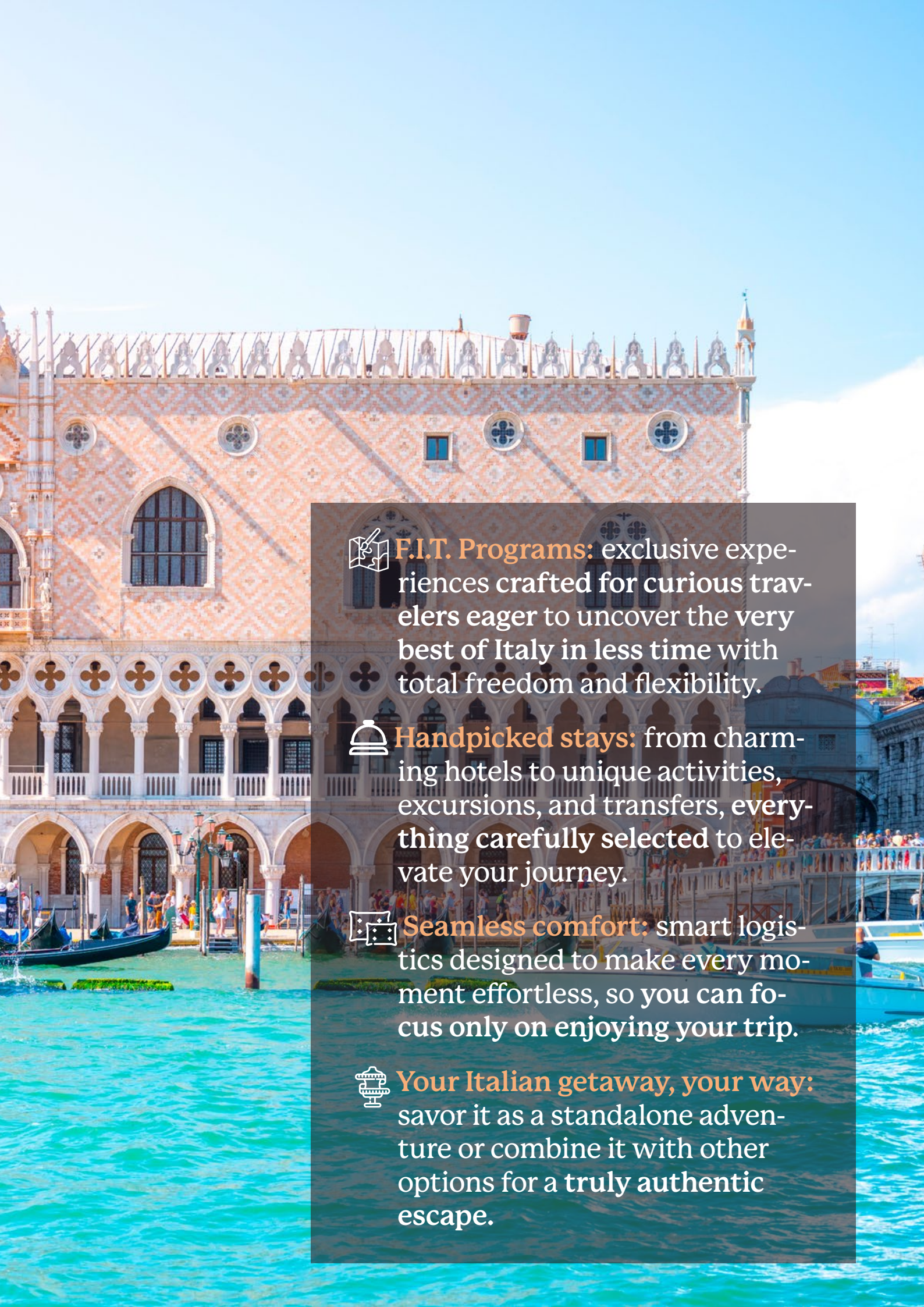

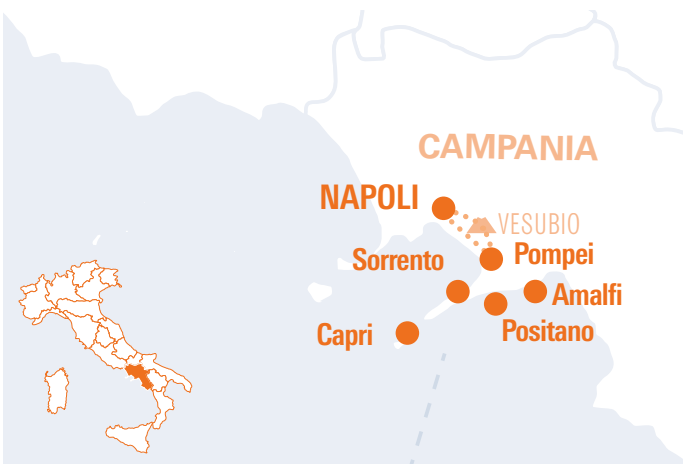

After breakfast at your hotel, **pick up at 08:10 AM** approx. and be ready for this full-day regular excursion. Explore the ancient **ruins of Pompeii with the local guide**, then hike to the summit of Mt. Vesuvius and peer into the crater. In **Pompeii**, visit the excavations: the **Forum, Thermal Baths, Vetti's house, and Lupanare**, all burnt by volcanic ashes during the eruption in **79 A.D.** After **Pompeii**, drive up **Mt. Vesuvius** and stop in a local restaurant

for a typical Italian **light lunch (water included)**. Then, **our driver brings you to 1000 m** altitude. From there, walk to the top of the volcano to see the crater. At the summit, enjoy the explanation by a professional **guide of the National Park** or explore independently. Admire the summit of **Mount Somma (1133 m)** and the cone of **Vesuvius (1281 m)**, separated by the **Valley of the Giant**. Mt. Vesuvius is majestic and stunning. It is absolutely worth visiting. **Return** to your hotel in **Naples at 04:30 PM** approx. Overnight stay.

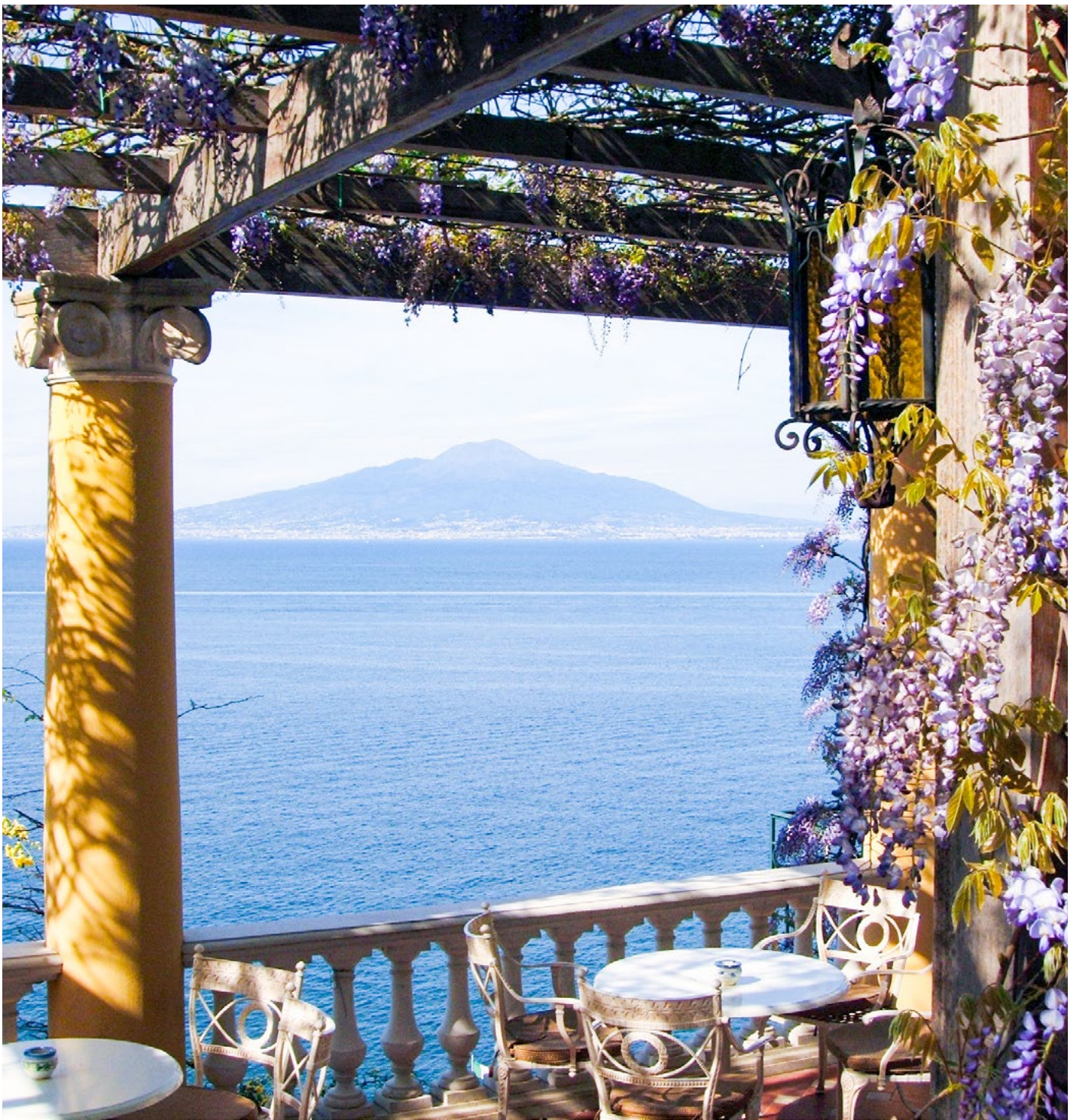

If you dream of experiencing some of Italy's most breathtaking coastal towns, join us on this unforgettable journey to **Sorrento Coast**.

Pack your bags and wear comfortable shoes — at 6:30 approx. we'll pick you up directly from your hotel and take you to the bus departure point.

Departing from Rome at 7:30 AM, enjoy a comfortable drive through the Italian countryside with a short stop along the way before continuing south towards the ancient city of **Pompeii**, set at the foot of Mount Vesuvius. Upon arrival, explore this remarkable **UNESCO World Heritage Site** with an expert licensed guide on a comprehensive archaeological tour. Enjoy an in-depth 2.5-hour exploration of the site, designed to let you fully immerse yourself in the history and daily life of ancient Rome. 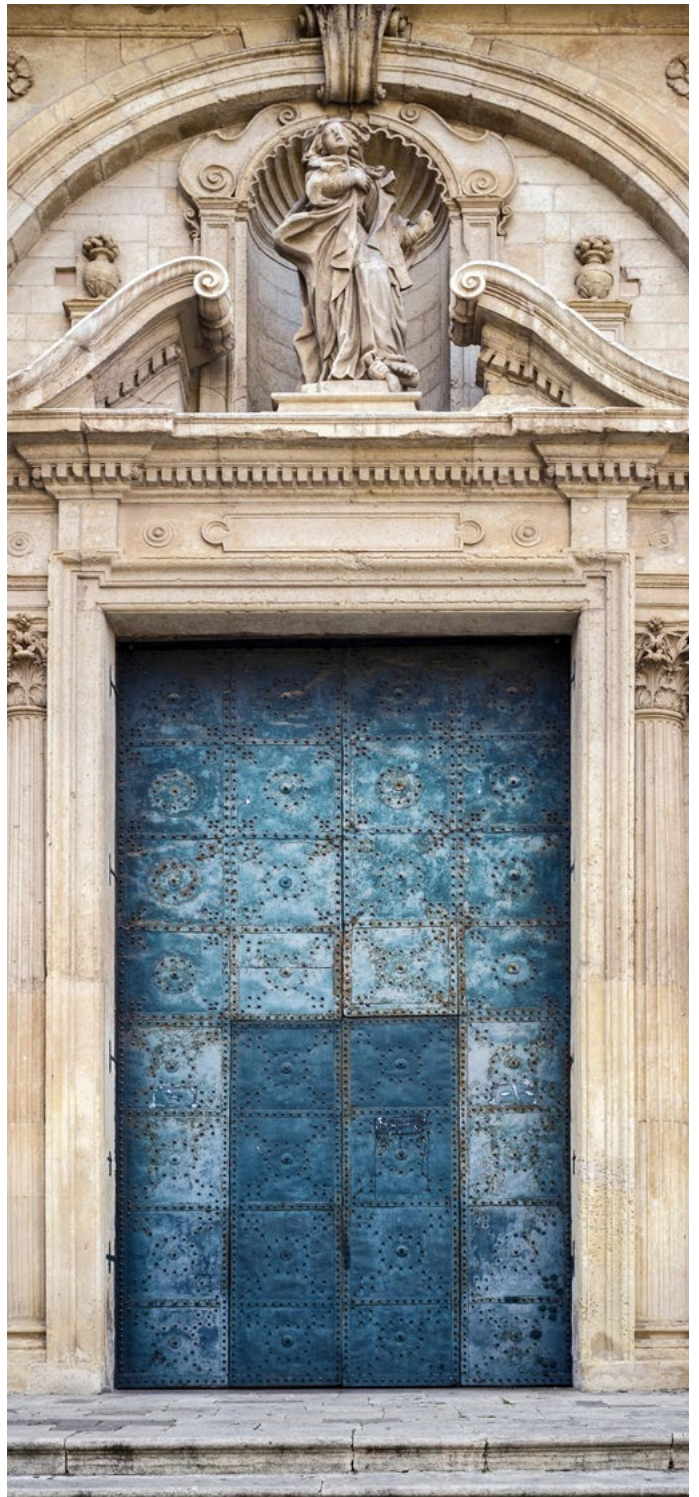

DAY 1 Lecce

Welcome to **Lecce!** **Make your own way** to your **hotel** and then enjoy your first day in the city at your own leisure. Overnight stay.

DAY 2 Lecce

After breakfast at your hotel, meet your guide at 10:30 AM (or at 05:45 PM except on Sundays) in Porta Rudiae and start an unforgettable Experience, immersive food tour that amounts to a full meal—or even more! Our dedicated local guide will take you on a culinary journey through Lecce's historic center, exploring authentic Salento flavors based on the best seasonal ingredients available. The tour offers a comprehensive tasting journey through Lecce's savory and sweet specialties.

Based on availability and seasonality, there will be 4 tastings included among the following:

Rustico: A beloved symbol of Lecce's snack culture, the rustico is a warm, flaky pastry filled with silky béchamel, stretchy mozzarella, and a touch of tomato. You'll often see locals enjoying it at mid-morning or aperitivo time at the bar. Bite into the crisp, golden shell and you'll understand why this humble street snack is a true delight.

Puccia: Born from the rustic traditions of Salento, the puccia is a wood-fired, round bread split open and stuffed to the brim. Fillings can range from grilled sausage and local cheeses to sun-dried tomatoes, seasonal vegetables, and fragrant olive oil. It's the kind of street food workers, students, and families grab on the go – a portable feast that captures the generous, countryside flavors of Puglia in one hearty bite.

Pittule: Pittule are golden fritters that appear on every Lecce table when there's something to celebrate – from Christmas markets to village festivals. The dough is light and airy, sometimes plain, sometimes enriched with olives, capers, or anchovies for a briny kick. Eaten steaming hot from the paper bag, they tell the story of Salento's simple, shared family recipes that have turned leftover dough into irresistible street food.

Caffè Leccese: More than just a drink, Caffè Leccese is a sum-

meritime ritual across Salento's cafés. Intense espresso is poured over ice and sweetened with almond syrup, a nod to the region's centuries-old almond-growing tradition. The result is a refreshing, layered coffee that's both velvety and energizing – locals linger over it in shaded piazzas while the afternoon heat shimmers on Lecce's baroque stone façades.

Pasticciotto: The pasticciotto is Lecce's most iconic pastry, traditionally enjoyed warm for breakfast at the bar. A shortcrust shell, just firm enough to hold, cradles a rich, silky custard that melts as you bite. First created in nearby Galatina in the 18th century, this little tart has become a proud emblem of Salento's pastry art – simple, generous, and deeply comforting with every spoonful of coffee alongside.

Fruppone: With its glossy chocolate glaze and heart of almond paste, fruttone is a classic dessert of Lecce's convent baking tradition. Beneath the dark coating, you'll find a dense, fragrant almond filling that sometimes hides a layer of jam or candied fruit. Once reserved for feast days and religious celebrations, today it brings a taste of the city's sweet heritage to pastry counters, one carefully crafted bite at a time.

Gelato: In Lecce, gelato is an evening ritual as much as a dessert. Artisan gelaterie churn flavors that celebrate Salento's produce: intense pistachio, roasted almond, figs from nearby countryside, or tart seasonal fruits. Strolling past baroque churches with a cone in hand, you'll understand how locals turn a simple gelato into a slow, sweet way of enjoying the city's golden twilight streets.

Local Beer: Lecce's emerging craft beer scene pairs regional character with modern creativity. Small breweries experiment with local grains, citrus, and Mediterranean herbs, producing refreshing lagers and aromatic ales that match beautifully with salty fritters and rich cheeses. Sipping a cold pint in a lively piazza, you'll taste how contemporary Salento is reinterpreting its agricultural roots one glass at a time.

The itinerary proceeds with visits to the Romanesque Cathedral and the imposing **Swabian Castle**, followed by a stop at a traditional local shop, a landmark of the area since 1866. Continue through the iconic Arco Basso, where you can observe local artisans handcrafting pasta along the famous "**Orecchiette Street**," and conclude the experience with a **tasting** of freshly baked focaccia or artisanal gelato. Rest of the day at your own total disposal. Overnight stay.

Board a train from **Rome Termini** to **Foggia**, where you will meet your **private car** and driver, who will take you to your **hotel** in **San Giovanni Rotondo**, home of the **Shrine of Padre Pio** Stop in **Monte Sant'Angelo** for about one hour. Settle into your hotel to rest up for the day ahead.

DAY 2

San Giovanni Rotondo

After breakfast at your hotel, spend the **day exploring** this fascinating **city on your own**. From July 28, 1916, until his death on September 23, 1968, **Padre Pio**, famous for his stigmata, called **San Giovanni Rotondo** his home. The miracle of his stigmata was recognized by the Pope after the approval of the three commis-

sions canonically required. The Medical Consultations of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints examined the case, and with a unanimous vote judged it "scientifically inexplicable." On June 16, 2002, **John Paul II** declared **Padre Pio** a Saint of the **Catholic Church**. Millions of people exulted with joy and participated in the ceremony at **Saint Peter's Square**. His body was exhumed in March of 2009 and displayed at **Santa Maria Delle Grazie shrine**, where it stayed until September 2009. After this intense day, return to your hotel for some well-earned rest.

Arancini: Born from Sicily's long love affair with rice during the Arab domination, these golden, deep-fried cones are filled with rich ragù, creamy spinach, smoked provola, pistachios, or eggplant, then breaded and fried until perfectly crispy. In Catania, arancini are the classic street snacks: hearty, easy to carry, and perfect to enjoy while strolling among baroque churches and lively markets.

Sicilian Caponata: This iconic sweet-and-sour mix of fried eggplant, tomato, celery, onions, olives, and capers tells the story of Sicily as a crossroads of the Mediterranean. A touch of sugar and vinegar creates the island's characteristic agrodolce flavor, once reserved for aristocratic tables. Today, caponata is shared as a beloved appetizer or side dish, best enjoyed with crusty bread and good company in a lively Catanese trattoria.

Fried Seafood Cone: Inspired by the daily catch from the nearby Ionian Sea, this crispy paper cone overflows with small fish, calamari, and seafood fried until light and crunchy. It brings the

flavors of Catania's historic fish market straight into your hands, finished with a squeeze of lemon and the background chorus of vendors calling out the freshest catch. It's a true street food ritual for locals on the go.

Cipollina Catanese: This beloved Catanese specialty wraps sweet slow-stewed onions, cooked ham, and melted cheese inside delicate layers of buttery puff pastry. Baked until perfectly golden, it combines the warmth of a homemade meal with the convenience of street food. Locals enjoy a cipollina for breakfast, a quick lunch, or a late-night snack, making it one of the city's most authentic everyday pleasures.

Cartocciata: A symbol of Catania's traditional rosticceria culture, the cartocciata is a soft, fluffy dough folded around generous fillings such as mozzarella, tomato, salami, or seasonal vegetables. Similar to a baked calzone but taller and softer, it's the kind of snack generations of students, workers, and families have grown up with. Every bakery adds its own touch, turning a simple bite of street food into a comforting taste of local life.

Sicilian Cannoli: Once prepared for winter celebrations in Sicilian convents, cannoli are now the island's most famous dessert. Their crispy, bubbly shells are fried and then filled at the last moment with velvety ricotta cream, candied orange peel, dark chocolate chips, or crunchy pistachios. In Catania, enjoying a freshly made cannolo is more than dessert—it's a sweet celebration of tradition, color, and Sicilian hospitality.

Sicilian Granita: This creamy frozen creation has Arab roots and has become the favorite way for locals to start the day or escape the afternoon heat. Made with fresh fruit or almonds, sugar, and finely crushed ice, granita is often paired with a soft brioche for a seaside breakfast. Slowly savored, it turns a simple break into a refreshing local ritual under the Sicilian sun.

It's the flavor of school breaks, football matches and family walks, and the most authentic way to begin your Sicilian food journey.

Panino ca meuza: this iconic spleen sandwich is Palermo's boldest specialty, cherished by locals at historic friggitorie around the Capo and Vucciria markets. Thin slices of spleen and lung are slow-cooked, then sizzled in fragrant lard and tucked into a soft bun, often with a sprinkle of caciocavallo cheese. Adventurous and deeply traditional, it tells the story of nose-to-tail cooking and centuries of working-class ingenuity.

Sfincione: more than "Palermo pizza," sfincione is a thick, cloud-soft focaccia topped with sweet tomato sauce, anchovy paste, slow-cooked onions and a generous dusting of breadcrumbs and cheese. Historically baked by women called "sfincionare" and sold from wooden carts at Christmas and feast days, it carries the scent of alleys and markets. Every bite blends sea flavors, street bustle and family-table comfort.

Rice arancina: this golden rice ball, crisp outside and silky within, is one of Sicily's most beloved icons. Influenced by Arab rice dishes and medieval court banquets, arancine are filled with classics like ragù, mozzarella, spinach or ham before being breaded and deep-fried. In Palermo they're a daily ritual, eaten on the go or during celebrations, turning a simple snack into a feast in your hand.

Sicilian cannoli: once prepared for Carnival in Sicilian convents, cannoli are now a symbol of celebration all year round. A bubbly, fried wafer is wrapped around a metal tube, then filled at the last moment with velvety sheep's ricotta, lightly sweetened and speckled with candied fruit, pistachios or dark chocolate drops. With every crunchy, creamy bite you taste generations of pastry craft and Sicily's love for true delight. Do you want to try this at home? You can find the recipe here.

Sicilian granita: born from Arab sherbets and snow from Mount Etna, granita is Sicily's coolest tradition. Finely crushed ice blends with fresh fruit, sugar and natural flavors into a slow-melting, fragrant dessert sipped from a glass, often with brioche in the morning. Lemon, almond, coffee or chocolate: each spoonful offers a refreshing pause from Palermo's sun-drenched streets and a gentle, elegant end to a hearty meal. Overnight stay in Palermo.
