Explore the famous islands of the Venice lagoon! You'll watch glass-blowers at work on Murano, shop for lace on Burano and visit Venice's first church on the tranquil island of Torcello.

After sailing past the island of San Giorgio Maggiore, the Public Gardens, the tip of Sant'Elena and the lido famous beach resort, the boat arrives at Murano, known throughout the world for its glass manufacturing industry. Here you have 1 hour and 15 minutes for a visit to one of the factories, and discover the magic of the glass. The second stop will be at the picturesque island of Burano, famous not only for its lace, but also for the fisherman's houses painted in bright colors. The stop will last about 1 hour and 30 minutes. After a short sail, you will reach Torcello, the earliest centre of civilization in the lagoon. Only the Cathedral with its magnificent mosaics and the church of Santa Fosca remains as the testimony of its former glory. This stop lasts about 1 hour. Then the boat will make its way back to St. Mark's Square.

Explore the famous islands of the Venice lagoon! You'll watch glass-blowers at work on Murano, shop for lace on Burano and visit Venice's first church on the tranquil island of Torcello. The stop in each island is approx. of 1 hour.

After 30 minutes of navigation, you will arrive at Murano where you can experience a live Glass blowing demonstration inside one of our traditional factory.

The second stop will be at the picturesque island of Burano, famous not only for its lace, but also for the fisherman's houses painted in bright colors. This tiny but unique Venetian Island town is enriched by typical shops, restaurants and excellent bakeries where you can buy the famous "Buranelli" biscuits.

Peculiarity of the tour is the inclusion of a typical fish lunch to be tasted in Burano in a selected restaurant. The menu will include: Pennette pasta with mixed fish, mixed fried fish, mixed salad, dessert of the day (coffee and drinks not included, to be paid on spot). The child menu will include: Pasta with tomato sauce or pasta with ragout sauce, fried cutlet milanese type with french fries and dessert of the day.

The tour continues after lunch with the last stop of the three scheduled which is Torcello Island, which is the earliest centre of civilization in the estuary. Then the boat will make its way back to St. Mark's Square.
