Pick up time from centrally-located hotels:

Our pick-up service takes place in the centre of Rome. Depending on traffic conditions and on the number of passengers who booked that specific tour, it takes around one hour for the bus to pick up all of the passengers. For this reason, pick-up times are shown as an interval. "Starting from 7:30" means that in order to be on time for the beginning of the tour, we will pick up you from your hotel at 7:30 or later.

Dress Code and Clothing Restrictions:

In Rome, especially in places of worship and inside the Vatican Museums, it is strictly forbidden to bring strollers, bulky bags and umbrellas.

Above-the-knee skirts and pants, low-cut clothing and sleeveless tops are never allowed in places of worship and inside the Vatican. Guests who fail to respect the attire requirements may be turned down at the entrance of the point of interest, therefore we suggest wearing or bringing appropriate clothes before the beginning of the tour.

Important notes:

If you have a metal coated pacemaker, you have to show your pacemaker identification card at the Security checks.

Sistine Chapel on your own: exclusive entrance at opening

The 54th gallery of the Vatican Museums is the famed Sistine Chapel. Completed around 1483, the Sistine Chapel is arguably one of the most admired sacred spaces in the world: still used for religious purposes such as the Papal conclave, the process through which a new Pope is chosen, it houses some incredible artwork.

The amazing frescoes located within are legendary: Michelangelo's The Last Judgement is world-famous and even appeared in movies - think Dan Brown's Angels and Demons.

Being such a gem, the Sistine Chapel ends up being the most visit area of the Vatican Museums: it's almost impossible to access it when the crowds are away.

Ancient basilicas and underground catacombs

Rome's churches are among the most beautiful and ancient in the Western world: spend an afternoon discovering some of them on this guided tour.

Even more ancient, Saint John Lateran Basilica: the oldest public church in Rome as well as the highest-ranked papal major basilica. It stands over the remains of a military Roman imperial fort established in AD 193 that was later converted into a place of worship and suffered several damages due to earthquakes and fires: the stunning façade as it appears today was completed in 1735.

In the nearby, the Scala Sancta (the Holy Stairs): white marble steps encased in wooden ones.

According to Catholic tradition, they formed the staircase leading up to the praetorium of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem on which Jesus stepped during his Passion.

And talking ancient, the Catacombs of St. Callixtus deserve a visit: these underground burial places, outside the walls of the city, were carved through tuff, a soft volcanic rock. More than fifty martyrs and early Popes were buried in this huge graveyard.

Ancient basilicas and underground catacombs

Rome's churches are among the most beautiful and ancient in the Western world: spend an afternoon discovering some of them on this guided tour.

Wake up in the morning at your centrally located hotel and wait for our driver to come and pick you up. You'll reach the Vatican area where you'll meet your professional guide who'll provide you with a convenient audio receiver and earphones, to make sure you won't miss a single word.

We'll visit Saint Mary Major, an ancient, stunning Basilica. It was built on the summit of the Esquiline Hill: its original architecture was classical, maybe to convey the idea the place represented the ancient Imperial as well as the Christian Rome. Despite several additional construction projects and damages, the Basilica retains the core of its original 442 AD structure.

Even more ancient, Saint John Lateran Basilica: the oldest public church in Rome as well as the highest-ranked papal major basilica. It stands over the remains of a military Roman imperial fort established in AD 193 that was later converted into a place of worship and suffered several damages due to earthquakes and fires: the stunning façade as it appears today was completed in 1735.

In the nearby, the Scala Sancta (the Holy Stairs): white marble steps encased in wooden ones.

According to Catholic tradition, they formed the staircase leading up to the praetorium of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem on which Jesus stepped during his Passion.

And talking ancient, the Catacombs of St. Callixtus deserve a visit: these underground burial places, outside the walls of the city, were carved through tuff, a soft volcanic rock. More than fifty martyrs and early Popes were buried in this huge graveyard.

Tivoli and its Villas

A few kilometers away from Rome, there's a world-renowned town, hosting two UNESCO World Heritage Sites: Tivoli.

It's here that, back in the 2nd century AD, the emperor Hadrian built his majestic villa: a luxury country residence where he used to retreat and where he lived his late years.

The huge complex includes more than 30 buildings, several swimming pools, former thermal stations and covers an area that's larger than a square kilometer, which gives quite an idea of this place's aim: to show the greatness, opulence and vast power of the emperor.

In the 16th century, much of the remaining marble and statues were removed

from Hadrian's Villa by Cardinal Ippolito II d'Este, to decorate his own villa located nearby: Villa d'Este, another UNESCO world heritage site.

Largely frescoed on the inside, the Villa is surrounded by a unique garden, displaying a complex system of pools, water jets, channels, fountains, cascades, and water games.
