This tour begins with a visit to Catania Cathedral, in Piazza Duomo, where you will meet a local guide. It is a marvelous example of Baroque style. After the Cathedral, you will head to the fish market, where you will taste some very typical products. For those who preferably eat fish as opposed to meat, the best fried fish in town is fritto di paranza. You will continue along Via dei Crociferi, famous for its churches, Via Etnea (Catania's main artery, that connects the beautiful Piazza del Duomo with Tondo Gioeni), and reach Piazza Stesicoro – with the ruins of a Roman amphitheater. From there it's super easy to reach Bar Savia, the right place to taste the best arancini in Catania, while the famous

cipolline alla catanese await you at the Panetteria Pacini (they are savory pies filled with tomato, onion, mozzarella and ham). Chiosco Costa is next: here you'll taste a typical sparkling drink made with seltz (similar to soda water) and syrups. In the next stop, near the city's harbor, a mixed plate of meat and grilled meatballs as well as the so-called cipollate (green part of spring onions wrapped in bacon) will be yours to try. A must! The last stop is dedicated to pastries, including the famous cannoli with ricotta, the cassatelle and finally the equally famous granite (a semi-frozen dessert made from sugar, water and various flavorings). This is an unmissable experience in Catania! Don't miss out!

Along the main street of this town, Corso Umberto, with the Messina Gate below and the Catania Gate on the mountain side, you will easily spot the most important monuments in Taormina: Palazzo Corvaja, Teatro Antico, Piazza IX Aprile, the Torre dell'Orologio (Clock Tower), the Cattedrale Fortezza, the Badia Vecchia (Old Abbey), and the Palazzo Duchi di Santo Stefano. Shopping is a valid option because Taormina is also famous for its exclusive boutiques. We will return to Catania in the evening.

You will then do some trekking in one of the paths in Etna Park around Rifugio Sapienza (1900 m/6234 ft) so you can enjoy a breathtaking sunset from the Silvestri craters. We will return to Catania in the evening.

Finally, we'll visit the Gole: small canyons carved by the river in lava basalt formations of Mount Etna. Columnar basalt is typical of this area. An overwhelming feeling will capture you!

This tour will begin with a visit to the Archaeological Park of Neapolis in Syracuse, a testimony of Greek and Roman Syracuse. You'll admire the Greek theater used for classical performances, the Roman amphitheater – from the period when Syracuse maintained the status of capital of the Roman government of Sicily and seat of the praetor, the latomie (old limestone quarries) – the famous Ear of Dionysius and the Grotta dei Cordari - the Altar of Hieron, a monumental grand altar built in the Hellenistic period by King Hiero II, and finally the Chiesa di San Nicolò ai Cordari, one of the first churches built here in Syracuse. You'll then take a tour to Ortygia, the heart of Syracuse, built on an island. You will

see Greek temples, Christian churches, Arabic streets, important old palaces, the Fountain of Arethusa – with its papyrus plants – and Cathedral of Syracuse, built as a Greek doric temple and surrounded by some beautiful baroque palaces. After lunch (not included in the price), we will head to Noto, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The town is a true "open air museum", famous for its buildings from the early 18th century deemed the finest examples of Sicilian baroque style. It is also a place of a number of religious buildings and astounding palaces. From Noto will return to Catania.

The tour will begin with a visit to Giardini Naxos, the first Greek colony in Sicily, founded in 734 BC. After driving along the coast and admiring the beautiful Naxos Bay, you will head to Castelmola. On our way there, we'll stop at a panoramic area overlooking Isola Bella, a Wildlife Reserve – called the "pearl of the Ionian Sea" for its natural beauty – connected to the mainland by a thin strip of sand. It is possible to embrace the whole bay from here, as well as cape Sant'Andrea, where the Grotta Azzurra (blue grotto) is located, and Capo Taormina. In Castelmola you will walk through the characteristics streets of the town, and stop to see the ruins of the Norman walls as well as the main square (Duomo) with the Mother Church, dedicated to St. Nicholas of

Bari, rebuilt between 1934 and 1935 on the existing cathedral. The second part of the excursion will be dedicated to visiting the picturesque town of Taormina. Along the main street of this town, Corso Umberto, with the Messina Gate below and the Catania Gate on the mountain side, you will easily spot the most important monuments in Taormina: Palazzo Corvaja, Teatro Antico, Piazza IX Aprile, the Torre dell'Orologio (Clock Tower), the Cattedrale Fortezza, the Badia Vecchia (Old Abbey), and the Palazzo Duchi di Santo Stefano. Shopping is a valid option because Taormina is also famous for its exclusive boutiques. We will return to Catania in the evening.

This tour will begin with a visit to Savoca, a picturesque medieval village in northern Sicily. It is listed in I Borghi più belli d'Italia (an association of small Italian towns of historical interest). This fascinating town has been chosen over the years as the set for a number of films. Among these, the most famous is undoubtedly "The Godfather", by Francis Ford Coppola. We will start from one of the most important places in Savoca, the Vitelli Bar, then set off on a stroll through the alleys of the village, immersed in an evocative landscape. You will see the ruins of an ancient synagogue and visit the Chiesa di San Nicolò - built in the 13th century and restored in the 18th century. In 1970 some scenes of The Godfather were shot just near this church. We will then head to Forza d'Agrò, embedded in the D'Agrò Valley. Here you will be able to enjoy breathtaking views of the valley and admire the clear traces of intense farm activity in a recent past. You can

also enjoy a beautiful panorama that overlooks the Ionian coast. Forza d'Adrò was also the location for the scenes set in Corleone of Coppola's The Godfather; it's also featured in the sequel, The Godfather Part II (1974). We'll make a quick stop to visit the Chiesa della Santissima Annunziata dating back to the 15th century. The tour will end with some free time to visit the picturesque town of Taormina. Along the main street of this town, Corso Umberto, with the Messina Gate below and the Catania Gate on the mountain side, you will easily spot the most important monuments in Taormina: Palazzo Corvaja, Teatro Antico, Piazza IX Aprile, the Torre dell'Orologio (Clock Tower), the Cattedrale Fortezza, the Badia Vecchia (Old Abbey), and the Palazzo Duchi di Santo Stefano. Shopping is a valid option because Taormina is also famous for its exclusive boutiques. We will return to Catania in the evening.

On this boat tour you will live an overwhelming experience! Sailing along the coast to Acì Trezza (a small seaside village of ancient Greek tradition and mythology), you'll find yourself in the Marine Protected Area of Isola Lachea noted for the so-called Cyclopean Isles (or Isole Ciclopi), rows of basaltic columns piled one above another. You'll also see the famous Faraglioni (sea stacks) where the coastline suddenly rises up to 200-300m upon the sea level... The small archipelago of islands and islets rose from the sea following massive land movements of elevation, which

brought these formations to the surface that were previously underwater. Acì Trezza is also famous for being the place where the novel "I Malavoglia" by Giovanni Verga was set. We'll stop for a swim or a snorkeling experience to admire the seabed of the Marine Protected Area. You'll finally be able to spot the Acì Castello Castle, of medieval origins and excavated in lava rock. The light aperitivo (a glass of Prosecco or wine, sacks, pizza) will be served on board.
