



Children policy for regular half-day and full-day tours:

For applicable reductions or conditions please check the brochure.

Pick-up time from centrally-located hotels:

Our pick-up service takes place in the centre of Rome. 


Discover Ancient Rome: Walking tour from theater Marcello to the Colosseum

Get ready for an unforgettable archaeological adventure in Rome, and make sure to have comfortable shoes handy! This tour will take you on a fascinating journey through the ancient history of the city, with several walking stops. We will begin at the picturesque **Theater of Marcellus**, an ancient Roman amphitheater, where you can admire classical architecture and uncover the stories behind its arches, reminiscent of those of the Colosseum. The Theater serves as an interesting testament to the transition toward late Augustan classicism. From here, we will head to the Cordonata, a historic staircase leading to the top of the Capitoline Hill, where you will find the famous Piazza del Campidoglio, designed by the great Michelangelo. After visiting Piazza del Campidoglio, where the equestrian statue of Marcus Aurelius stands at its center—a rare surviving equestrian statue from ancient times, and surrounded by the Palazzo dei Conservatori, the Palazzo Senatorio, and the Palazzo Nuovo, home to the Capitoline Museums-, we will take in breathtaking views of the Roman Forum and the Palatine Hill from its summit, temples, ruins, and the impressive archaeological complex. The Roman Forum was the center of public and political life in the Roman Empire, and its ruins testify to Rome's glorious past. Highlights of this area include the Arch of Septimius Severus and the Temple of Saturn, both highly visible from the Capitoline Hill. Our journey will then lead us to Piazza Venezia, where you will encounter the imposing Monument to Victor Emmanuel II, also known as the "Altar of the Fatherland" or "the Wedding Cake". This monument is a grand architectural work and one of Rome's most iconic symbols. We will then continue along Via dei

Fori Imperiali, where we will see the Forum of Julius Caesar, with the ruins of Temple of Venus Genetrix, the Forum of Trajan and the famous Column, the Forum of Augustus, and the evocative Muro della Suburra, where you can admire the remains of ancient buildings and colonnades. From here, a perspective unfolds again onto the Roman Forum and the central building of the republican power: the Senate. It will be a unique opportunity to immerse oneself in the urban archaeology of Rome Next, we will pass by the Basilica of Maxentius. In the early 4th century (308-312), the basilica was initiated by Maxentius but completed with some design modifications by his victorious rival, Constantine. This grand architecture served as a model for the magnificent Christian basilicas, foremost among them St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. Our tour will continue at the Colosseum, the icon of Rome. Entrance is not included in the tour. With its majestic grandeur and its walls steeped in millennial of stories, this world-famous monument is the silent echo of gladiators and epic battles that once reverberated within its walls. Just opposite you will see the Arch of Constantine, a commemorative monument that celebrates the Emperor's victory over Maxentius in the Battle of Milvian Bridge. Here, we will discover the symbolic and political significance of triumphal processions. We will conclude in a magnificent corner of Rome, with a breathtaking view of the Colosseum. From the Colosseum, a small staircase leads to Via del Fagutale. At the top of this street, you will reach a modern bridge. Making a right turn, your guide will proceed to Via del Monte Oppio, and you will find yourselves near a gate. Passing through one of its doors, a splendid terrace will offer an exclusive view

of the **Colosseum**, one of the world's most famous monuments. From this amazing spot, you will be able to take all the best pictures you want of Rome's most iconic building. It's a fairly strenuous walking tour, but every step will bring you closer to the history and grandeur of ancient Rome thanks to the explanations and expertise of the accompanying local professional guide. Ancient Basilicas and underground Catacombs

Rome's churches are among the most beautiful and ancient in the Western world: spend an afternoon discovering some of them on this guided tour. We'll visit Saint Mary Major, an ancient, stunning basilica. It was built on the summit of the Esquiline Hill: its original architecture was classical, maybe to convey the idea the place represented the ancient Imperial as well as the Christian Rome. Despite several additional construction projects and damages, the basilica retains the core of its original 442 AD structure. Even more ancient, Saint John Lateran Basilica: the oldest public church in Rome as well as the highest-ranked papal major basilica. It stands over the remains of a military Roman imperial fort established in AD 193 that was later converted into a place of worship and suffered several damages due to earthquakes and fires: the stunning façade as it appears today was completed in 1.735. In the nearby, the Scala Sancta (the Holy Stairs): white marble steps encased in wooden ones. According to Catholic tradition, they formed the staircase leading up to the praetorium of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem on which Jesus stepped during his Passion. And talking ancient, the Catacombs of St. Callixtus deserve a visit: these underground burial places, outside the walls of the city, were carved through tuff, a soft volcanic rock. More than fifty martyrs and early Popes were buried in this huge graveyard.





Masterpieces unveiled: a journey through the Borghese Gallery

When in Rome, one cannot miss out on the Borghese Gallery, a museum that houses a very important art collection including works by Bernini, Caravaggio, Canova and Raphael. A professional local guide will illustrate the Gallery and its elegant, sophisticated and even regal interior and exterior spaces. The underlying sculptures and paintings in the building come from the private collection of cardinal Scipione Borghese (1579 - 1633), an art collector and patron, son of Ortensia Borghese, pope Paul V's sister. The cardinal's attention was directed to all Renaissance and contemporary art expressions, but wasn't really into medieval art. Thus, his ambitions favored sculptures and marble groups whose high standards rivalled those of ancient art. Pauline Bonaparte as Venus Victrix, sculpted by Canova between 1805 and 1808, has been here since 1838. In 1807 Camillo Borghese gave Napoleon 154 statues, 160 busts, 170 bas reliefs, 30 columns and a number of other objects that now make for a Borghese-derived Louvre catalog. Bernini's artworks (Apollo and Daphne, The rape of Proserpina, David, to name just a few) have a prominent position in the gallery's spaces on the first floor, too - so much so that one cannot but remain literally entranced by them. The collection of paintings is also very compelling: Pictures by Caravaggio, Titian, Correggio and Raphael are displayed on the second floor among many others. Tickets to the Gallery must be booked well in advance, but we take care of it! By booking this tour, access is secured and you won't have to pay anything at check-in. The tour also includes hotel pick-up. From any centrally located hotel, we'll reach the museum together with no stress by private minivan. A version without pick-up is an option (the tour will start at a meeting point). When the tour is over, we suggest lingering outside in Villa Borghese, the huge public garden where the Gallery is located. Everyone finds a walk along the villa's tree-flanked promenades very relaxing. The Pincio terrace is a twenty-minute walk, this being one of Rome's hills. From here one can enjoy wonderful views not only over Piazza del Popolo right below and the Prati district, but also St Peter's Dome, the Gianicolo, the Quirinale, Piazza Venezia as well as the Capitol hill. The outlook from the Pincio is really one of a kind!



The Jewish Ghetto of Rome

When you think of Rome's history and its great empire, you can't help but think that this wonderful city is the epitome of history itself. But Rome is great and generous even within itself. Of the old homes where thousands of Jews were isolated for centuries, almost nothing remains today. However, as you walk through the alleys of the ghetto, full of monuments, buildings, streets and in the eyes of some of the descendants of those who lived here in the past, you will find that inheritance still lives within them today. Visit one of Rome's most fascinating neighbourhoods with us and discover the history of one of the oldest **Jewish** communities in the world. Walk with our guide through the alleys of the Ghetto and discover traces of Imperial Rome such as the **Theatre of Marcellus** or **Portico of Octavia**. We will retrace the history of the Jewish people in the city of Rome, from ancient to modern times, without ever forgetting the victims of the Holocaust, of which the "stumbling stones" (concrete cubes bearing a brass plate) fixed into the floor are a tangible testimony. You will also have the chance to discover the typical recipes of traditional Jewish-Roman cuisine, such as delicious artichokes "alla giudia", or the tart with ricotta cheese and sour cherries. The ghosts and mysteries hidden in a city like Rome have perhaps always scared us a little, right? There, we will find the statue of an ancient Greek hero, or what remains of it: a bust and a "swollen" face. Leaving the statue, we then reach Piazza Navona. Restless souls also hover over the next stop, the **Pantheon**, a masterpiece of Roman engineering, first a pagan temple and then a Catholic church. We will finally arrive in Piazza della Minerva. At its center since 1667, we can admire the obelisk of the Minerva placed on the back of a small elephant known as "The little elephant of the Minerva". A little further away we will find Largo di Torre Argentina, where the great Julius Caesar was assassinated; one of the most eclectic and important figures of the Roman Empire, who still brings many mysteries with him. We will end our tour in Piazza Mattei, which takes its name from the palace of Giacomo Mattei that overlooks it.

Tivoli and its villas

A few kilometers away from Rome, there's a world-renowned town, hosting two UNESCO world heritage sites: ${\bf Tivoli}.$ It's here that, back in the 2nd century AD, the emperor Hadrian built his majestic villa: a luxury country residence where he used to retreat and where he lived his late years. The huge complex includes more than 30 buildings, several swimming pools, former thermal stations and covers an area that's larger than a square kilometer, which gives quite an idea of this place's aim: to show the greatness, opulence and vast power of the emperor. In the 16th century, much of the remaining marble and statues were removed from Hadrian's Villa by Cardinal Ippolito II d'Este, to decorate his own villa located nearby: Villa d'Este, another UNESCO worldheritage site. Largely frescoed on the inside, the Villa is surrounded by a unique garden, displaying a complex system of pools, water jets, channels, fountains, cascades, and water games. And what makes this system of fountains such an incredible masterpiece of engineering is that it works entirely by the force of gravity, without pumps. Leaving Rome in the morning, you'll have half a day to enjoy these architectural beauties accompanied by a professional guide, who'll provide you with an audio receiver and earphones: you won't miss a single detail! And you don't even need to wrap your head around how to reach Tivoli: you can either opt for our pick-up service from your centrally located hotel or save some dimes and reach us at our meeting point. We'll take care of both transportation and entrance tickets, all you have to do is relax and enjoy the trip.







Venice by high-speed train

Let us take you to Venice and back from Rome in just one day! No destination is too far away from Rome by high-speed trains. A tour leader will be with you to make sure you make it to Venice safely, show you around so you won't feel disoriented and give you tips that would do the trick. You will meet your leader at Roma Termini railways station for check-in. Follow him or her to the platform and get on the train with no stress. You will reach Venice in a bit more than 3 hours. From Venezia Santa Lucia railway station, you will reach a vaporetto stop (dock) located a stone's throw away. Enjoy the ride on the Venetian typical public transport waterbus, a fantastic way to start taking a glimpse at amazing views, architecture, historical buildings and churches façades, docks, gondolas, common residents running their errands and tourists doing their thing... The one-run ticket pass to the city center is included, and handed out by the tour leader. St. Mark's Square is the heart of the historical center. After getting off the vaporetto and a two-minute walk, simply take a left turn and take in the magnificence of the Western façade of St. Mark's Basilica. What makes Venice special is also the 118 small islands it is built on as well as the 400ish bridges that span the famous canals: from St. Mark, don't be afraid to get lost in the maze of alleys (or calli) to see them. Spend some time shopping, sipping an espresso in one of the quaint historical coffee shops, or even sitting at the outside table of a modern bar. Maybe make a stop (highly recommended) on the Bridge of Sighs (or Ponte dei sospiri), one of the most beautiful Insta spots for amazing shots. Orsanmichele exterior (a building constructed on the site of the kitchen garden of the no longer existing monastery of San Michele), the astounding Ponte Vecchio (a medieval stone arch bridge over the Arno River) and Piazza Signoria (the focal point of the origin and history of the Florentine Republic: this is where one can admire the 'David' sculpture by Michelangelo. actually a perfect copy of the original one housed in the Galleria dell'Accademia di Firenze for protection). After the walking tour you will access the famous Galleria degli Uffizi with no line to see its highlights up close. It is one of the most famous museums in the world. Among its countless works, vou will have the chance to admire the masterpieces of Botticelli, Leonardo, Michelangelo, Raphael, Titian and Caravaggio. Indeed, some of the priceless works to be seen and illustrated by the local guide are: Sandro Botticelli's The Birth of Venus, Caravaggio's Medusa, Artemisia Gentileschi's Judith Beheading Holofernes, Titian's Venus of Urbino. All their secrets will be unveiled by the local guide as he/she contextualizes their origins and the stories behind them. After completing the visit, there will be plenty of free time to explore a little bit of the city at your leisure and have lunch or a snack (not included in the price) at a nice restaurant or bar. 



Capri island and **Blue Grotto**

The tiny island of Capri has it all: good cuisine, jaw-dropping nature, lovely weather, stunning sights and one of the bluest waters in the whole Tyrrhenian sea.
