The Amphitheater created to entertain ancient Roman citizens with

bloody shows of gladiators, animals and cruel games, is now one of the most fascinating landmark of the City. Then, walk on the original path of ancient Rome along the Via Sacra and see the Temples of Vesta, Antonino and Faustina, the ancient Basilica Julia and Aemilia and dream about the glorious past of the Roman Empire. Visit the splendid Duomo Cathedral, a striking example of Gothic art and the largest church in Italy. Try to count the statue crammed onto its roof and façade, there are more than 3.200 of them, before following your guide in the visit of the interior. Exit the Duomo and walk inside Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II shopping gallery, a 19th century glass vaulted shopping arcade. Brimming with fashionable shops and cafes, it used to be the connecting path between the Cathedral and the La Scala Opera House, so the ladies could stay dry in their way to the theatre in case of rain. At the end of the Galleria you arrive at Milan's most famous Opera House: the fabulous La Scala theatre. Founded in 1.778 and still in use, some of the world's greatest musicians and opera singers have performed here including Pavarotti, Maria Callas and Giuseppe Verdi. Your entrance ticket provides 24 hours admission to the theatre and museum, so you can return the next day. Overnight stay.

DAY 4

Milan · Rome

After breakfast at your hotel, at the time indicated, head to Milano Centrale train station to reach Rome. Once there, make your own way to your hotel for the overnight stay.

DAY 5 Rome

After breakfast at your hotel, spend a leisurely day exploring the wonders of Rome at your own pace. 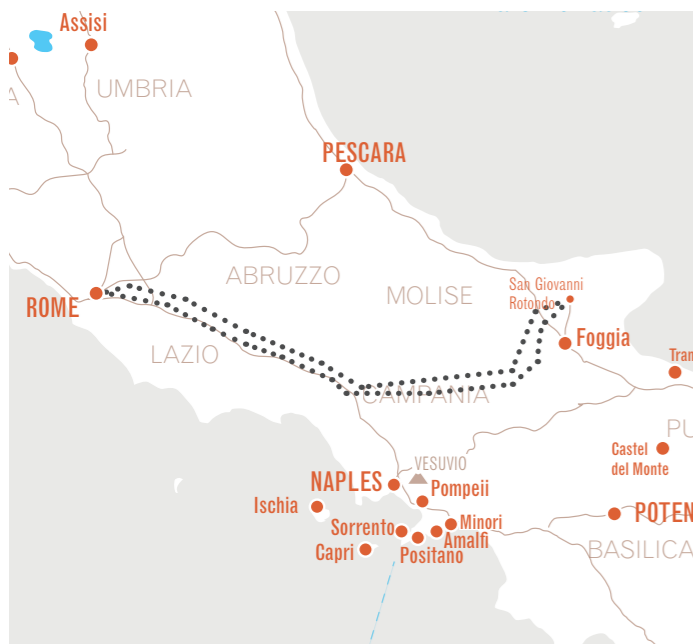

DAY 1

Rome · San Giovanni Rotondo

Board on a train from Rome Termini to Foggia, where you will meet your private car and driver, who will take you to your hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo, home of the Shrine of Padre Pio (opportunity to stop at Monte Sant'Angelo with a supplement). Settle in to your hotel to rest up for the day ahead.

DAY 2

San Giovanni Rotondo

After breakfast at your hotel, spend the day exploring this fascinating city on your own. From July 28, 1916

until his death on September 23, 1968, Padre Pio, famous for his stigmata, called San Giovanni Rotondo home. The miracle of his stigmata was recognized by the Pope after the approval of the three commissions canonically required. The Medical Consultations of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints examined the case, and with a unanimous vote judged it "scientifically inexplicable". Finally, the Pope officially recognized the miracle with the decree of December 21, 1998 and fixed the date for the Beatification for Sunday, May 2, 1999. Millions of people exulted with joy and participated in the ceremony at Saint Peter's Square. On June

16, 2002, Padre Pio was declared a Saint. His body was exhumed in March of 2009 and placed on display at the Santa Maria delle Grazie shrine, where it stayed until September 2009. After this intense day, return to your hotel for some well-earned relaxation.
