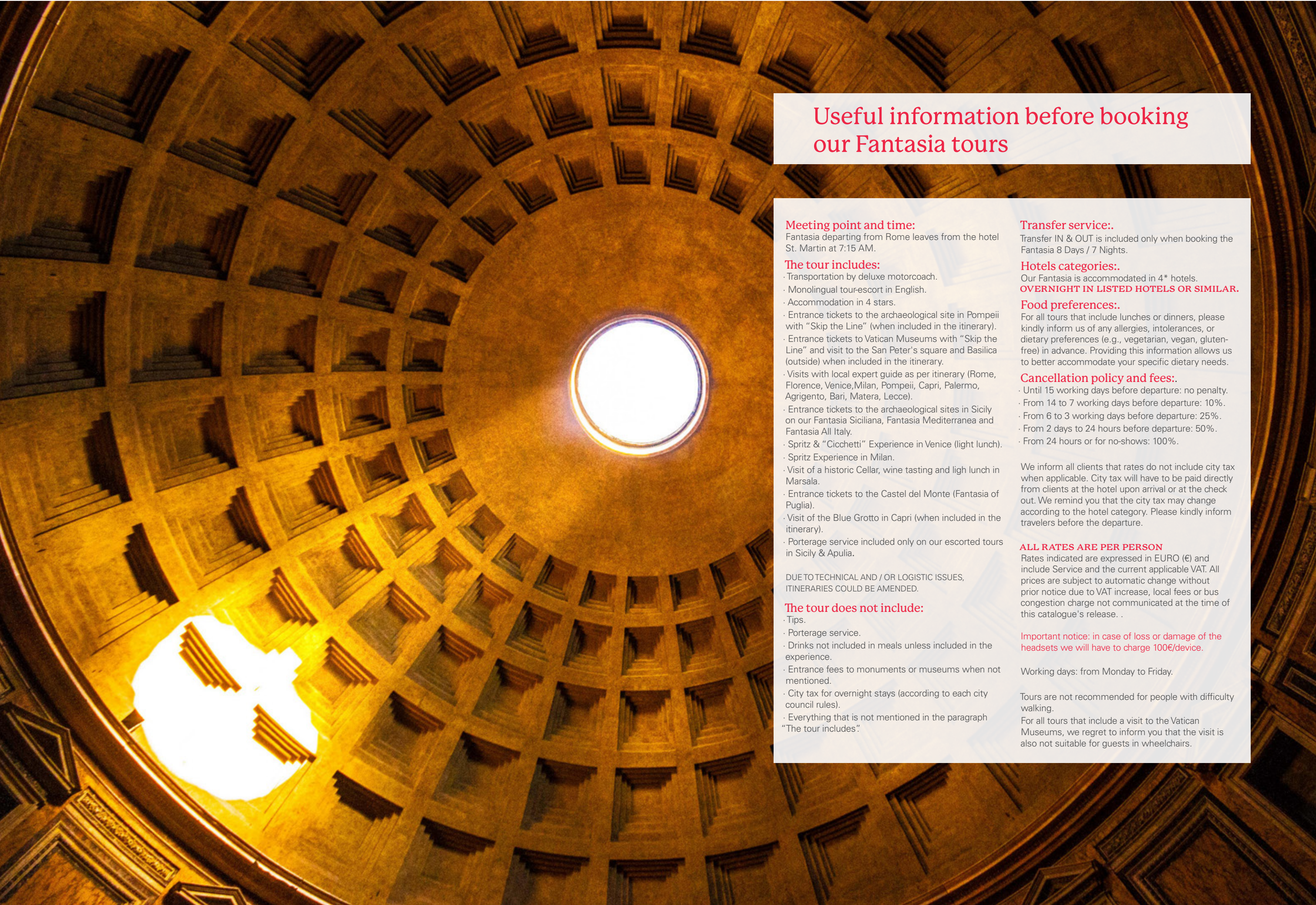

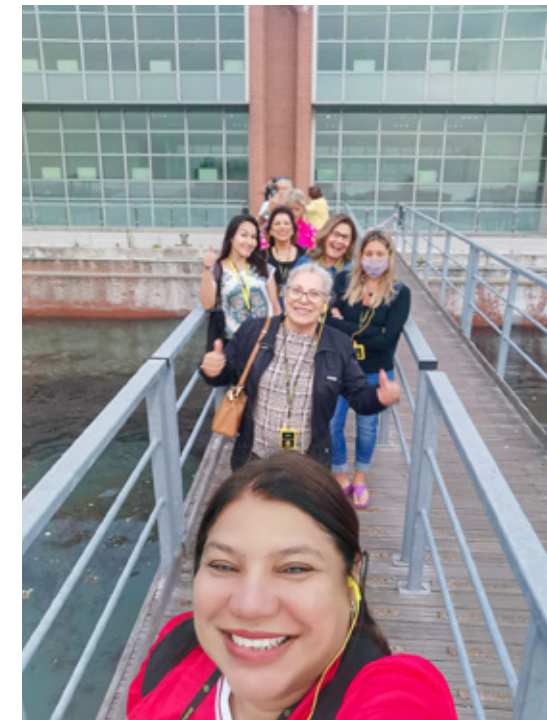

ITINERARY

DAY 1
Rome
